Programme Overview

On **14 July 2021**, the **Kedah Eco-Schools** Programme successfully hosted **Bengkel Eco-Schools 1 (Eco-Schools Workshop 1)** virtually with representatives from the Langkawi District Education Office, ten Eco-Schools from Langkawi and a speaker from SK Bukit Lintang. The first workshop provides an overview of the programme, touching on several key topics: **Introduction to Eco-Schools**, the **7 Steps Methodology of Eco-Schools presented by Cikgu Faizah**, **Eco-Schools Committee Formation**, **Writing of Meeting Minutes of Meeting** and **Appraisal Criteria for Step 1**. The workshop also includes a brief on the **Eco-Schools Preliminary Audit Form** and a **Self-Examination Session** where the participants are asked questions to test their knowledge about the workshop contents. This workshop is the first of its kind, and with that, a number of elements were taken into consideration in terms of its virtual implementation. All of the feedback and suggestions have been received and will be taken into practice for the next online workshop sessions. The development of the Eco-Schools Workshop 2 soon follows once the updates and materials have been uploaded on the website at www.paradigmakelestarian.com/ecoschoolskedah.

TOPICS DISCUSSED

1. *Pengenalan Eco-Schools (Introduction to Eco-Schools)*

Participants are briefly introduced to the origin, programme structure, International Module and impact of the Eco-Schools Programme. Under the same topic, participants are given a glimpse of the 17 sustainable development goals to transform the world, such as quality education and climate action.

2. *Metodologi 7 Langkah Eco-Schools oleh Cikgu Faizah (7 Steps Methodology of Eco-Schools by Cikgu Faizah)*

Cikgu Faizah, the Eco-Schools teacher coordinator of SK Bukit Lintang took over the presentation for the first step of the important 7 Steps Methodology of Eco-Schools; the establishment of the Eco-Schools Committee. The methods she implemented for the success of her school in being awarded the Green Flag were shared with the participants. Any recommendations in regard to her experience were thoroughly recounted.

3. *Pembentukan Jawatankuasa Eco-Schools (Eco-Schools Committee Formation)*

The third topic discussed correlated with the second topic, in which participants were enlightened further with important details about the formation of the Eco-Schools Committee. Participants were clarified with the components of the organisation, a template of the Eco-Schools Committee Members Chart, the functions of the Committee Members and the possible list of Exco roles that will be the main force behind the Committee.

4. *Penulisan Minit Mesyuarat* (Writing Minutes of Meeting)

For this topic, participants are explained about the meeting minutes, the functions of preparing minutes for the meeting, and how to write the minutes. This is to ensure that students know the steps to prepare minutes of meeting and for the teachers to guide the students to write the minutes of the meeting. In addition to that, the students can understand that preparing the minutes are their responsibility and must be planned among themselves of which the teachers will only be supervising their progress.

5. *Kriteria Penilaian* (Appraisal Criteria)

Towards the end of their Eco-Schools journey, a panel of independent auditors will evaluate the impact of the schools' eco-projects on the community before being awarded one of the three internationally recognised Eco-Schools awards. In this topic, participants are briefed on the achievement benchmarks that have been set for the committee, amount of students required to participate in this programme, awarding criteria and encouraged to set for the Green Flag award.

6. *Borang Audit Eco-Schools* (Eco-Schools Preliminary Audit Form)

In preparation for the **Eco-Schools Workshop 1 on 14 July 2021**, participants are instructed to collect their schools' preliminary environmental data to help the organiser assess the suitable intervention scheme and provide necessary guidance in future events. The data collected will provide a baseline, marking the start of the schools' environmental journey.

7. *Sesi Ujian Kendiri* (Self-Examination Session)

After the end of the presentation, some questions have been prepared for the students to answer as to see whether they are focused or taking notes about the presentation before. This can be used as a great measure for teachers to observe the readiness of their students regarding this programme.

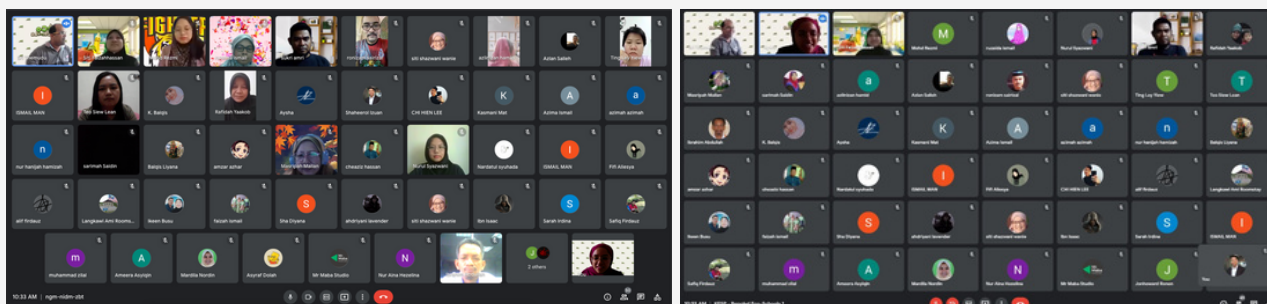
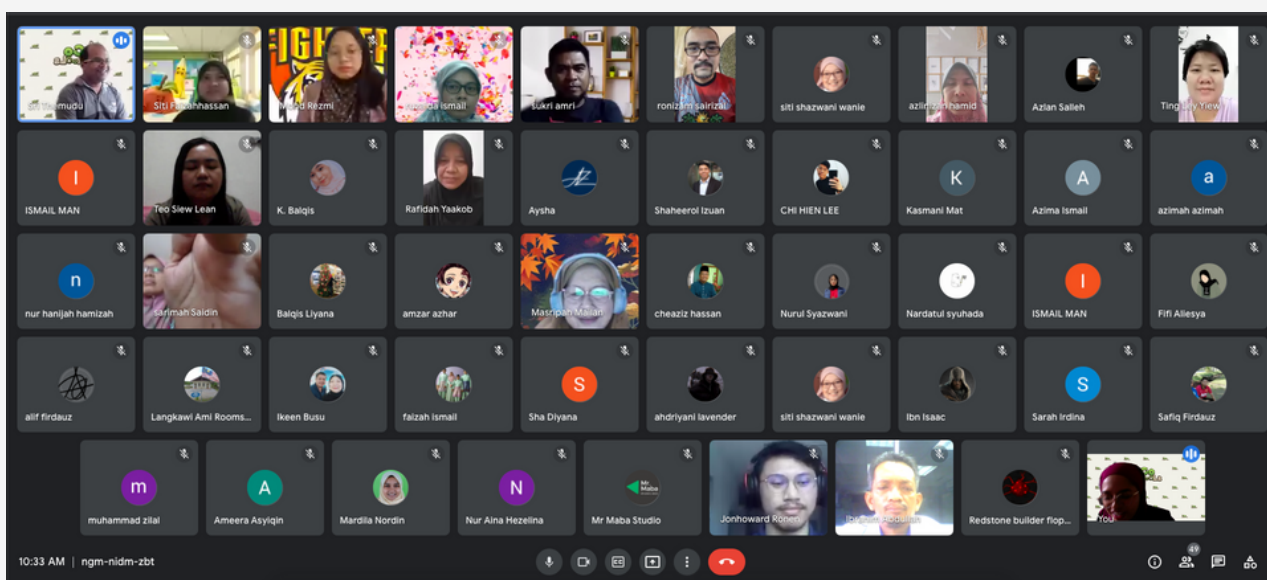
RECEPTION OF PARTICIPANTS
